He argued and won a major summary judgment motion in a case with estimated damages exceeding \$1.8 billion. In a putative antitrust class action, his client was the only one of seven defendants to obtain dismissal on summary judgment. He also achieved a rare early dismissal of cartel claims in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois, removing his client from the case before any discovery occurred.
